



CrossOver Office™ Professional Quick Start Installation

- Place the CrossOver CD in the drive, and mount it (Most newer Linux distributions do this automatically). To manually mount it from a console window, become the root user (command: su -) and then type mount -o exec /mnt/cdrom (where /mnt/cdrom is the appropriate path for the CD).
- Run install.sh. There are three ways to do this:
 1. If you have "auto-run" enabled, after the CD-ROM is mounted a window will appear asking if you would like to run auto-run – select Yes/OK.
 2. From a console window, type sh /mnt/cdrom/install.sh
 3. Double click on the CD-ROM and in the resulting file browser, double click on install.sh. You will be prompted with a window asking what to do with this file, click "Run."
- Agree to the CrossOver EULA and then click "Begin Install." Once the install has finished, click "Configure Now." After a couple configuration screens, the CrossOver Office Setup window will appear.
- To install Microsoft Office:
 - Click "Install" in CrossOver Office Setup
 - Select 'Microsoft Office <Version>' and click "Next."
 - Insert the Microsoft Office CD, select the CD-ROM, and click "Next."
- Go through the Microsoft Office installation as you would on Windows and at the end CrossOver will simulate a Windows Reboot (no Linux rebooting required!).
- File associations are set automatically, but they can be configured in CrossOver Office Setup under the "Associations" tab.
- Install Quicken, Visio, etc. as described above.
